Tips for TEEN Summer Job Seekers

- Search where others are not. Outdoor jobs involving heavy labor or behind-the-scenes jobs are often not as sought-after by teens.
- Look for odd jobs at odd hours. Offer to work evenings and night shifts and to fill in for vacationing employees. As a job-search strategy, conduct a search for these types of positions during the hours they operate.
- Do what good salesmen do - go door to door, business to business. Not only ask for an application but take the time to introduce yourself and build some rapport with hiring manager.

- Call relatives, they are often the best source of information on job leads because they have had time to build up a network.
- Dress for the part, even if your applying to work on a road crew, show up to all interviews in nice clothes. You want the interviewer to focus on you and your skills, not on your ripped jeans or concert t-shirt.
