Your opinion is important as we work together to improve the safety and security of our neighborhood. The following options have been discussed for improving the safety and security of our neighborhood.

- Neighborhood Watch – We implemented the neighborhood watch program in the 1990's and actively report suspicious activity or crime in our neighborhood.
- Supplemental Patrols – This would be an ongoing significant expense and provides limited additional coverage.
- Security Cameras – This would be a significant initial expense and require ongoing maintenance. Cameras provide consistence and continuous coverage. Missouri city police support the use of cameras but are not aware of any Missouri City subdivisions currently using cameras.
