Join First Colony Community Association (FCCA) for the 2nd Annual “Paws For A Cause” Dog Walk at the Sugar Land Memorial Park located at 15300 University Blvd. on October 9, 2010. Registration is \$20.00 which includes a goodie bag with a t-shirt for the first 100 registered and more. Enter your dog in the Best Dog Trick and Best Dog Costume contests-prizes will be awarded. Proceeds directly benefit the Sugar Land Animal Shelter which cares for strays, abandoned, and orphaned cats and dogs found on the streets of Sugar Land. By raising money for the Sugar Land Animal Shelter you will help the animals in their care. Located at 101 Gillingham, the shelter is open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, Saturdays from 10 am to 2 pm with extended hours on Thursday until 7 pm.

The route winds along the South Meadow Loop, along the Pawm Springs Dog Park, around the Lake Loop and finishes at the Pavilion. The trail covers a total of 2.25 miles. Or you can take the scenic route of the Lake Loop for 1.15 miles.
